Synopsis/Review:

Among the major literary journals are *Martin Fierro* in Argentina, *Contemporaneos* in Mexico, *Amauta* in Peru, and *El Hijo Pródigo* in Mexico. This Critical Index pays close attention to the contents of the 42 issues published from April 15, 1943-Sept. 15, 1946, with a note on the contents of each article. All studies of Mexican culture of the period should first consult this compendium and analysis"--*Handbook of Latin American Studies, v.* 58.

El Hijo Pródigo was the literary voice of the most important literati and artists of Mexico during the forties. Its literary boundaries extended to works from all over the world; still, it provided a forum for new Mexican writers like the future Nobel Laureate Octavio Paz among other prominent Mexican authors: Augustín Yáñez, Alfonso Reyes, Rodolfo Usigli, José Luis Martínez and Leopoldo Zea. It launched Mexico into prominence in the international literary arena.
